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1. Overview

1.1 Independent Hospital Pricing Authority

The Independent Hospital Pricing Authority (Pricing Authority) is established under the *National Health Reform Act 2011* (Cth) (Act), and by virtue of section 131(1) of the Act is invested with the following functions relevant to this 2019-20 National Efficient Cost (NEC) Determination (Determination):

- (a) to determine the national efficient cost for health care services provided by public hospitals where the services are block funded;
- (b) to develop and specify classification systems for health care and other services provided by public hospitals;
- (c) except where otherwise agreed between the Commonwealth and a State – to determine the public hospital functions that are to be funded in the state by the Commonwealth.

In this document, 'Pricing Authority' refers to the governing members and 'IHPA' refers to the agency.

1.2 Data quality

In making this Determination, the Pricing Authority has relied on the National Public Hospital Establishments Database (NPHEd), the National Hospital Cost Data Collection (NHCDC) and the following National Minimum Data Sets (NMDS) and National Best Endeavours Data Sets (NBEDS) to determine the key parameters of the model:

- Admitted Patient Care NMDS
- Admitted Subacute and Non-Acute Hospital Care NBEDS
- Activity based funding: Emergency Service Care NBEDS
- Non-Admitted Patient Care Aggregate NMDS and NBEDS.

The Pricing Authority has determined that the data are adequate to carry out its functions under the Act in 2019-20.

1.3 Terminology

Although the Pricing Authority aims to use plain English to make its documents accessible to a wide audience, the subject matter of this Determination requires the use of some specialist terms. For ease of reference, the meaning of those terms is set out in an [electronic glossary](#) available on the IHPA website.

2. Block funding criteria

Clauses A27 and A28 of the National Health Reform Agreement (NHRA) detail the process that the Pricing Authority is required to follow to determine the criteria for block funded hospitals:

- a. IHPA, in consultation with jurisdictions, develops block funding criteria and identifies whether hospital services and functions are eligible for block funding only or mixed Activity Based Funding (ABF) and block funding;
- b. States and territories, during the consultation period, assess their hospital functions and services against the block funding criteria and, if necessary, provide advice to IHPA on the potential impact of the criteria;
- c. IHPA provides the block funding criteria to the Council of Australian Governments (COAG) for endorsement; and
- d. COAG considers the block funding criteria proposed by IHPA and either:
 - i. endorses the recommendation; or
 - ii. requests IHPA to refine the block funding criteria and bring it back to COAG.

States and territories provide advice to IHPA on how their hospital services and functions meet the block funding criteria on an annual basis. For small rural and small regional hospitals, this advice can be provided once every six years, or more frequently at the discretion of the state or territory.

The Pricing Authority provided the following draft block funding criteria to COAG for consideration.

Public hospitals, or public hospital services, will be eligible for block grant funding if:

1. the technical requirements for applying ABF are not able to be satisfied; or
2. there is an absence of economies of scale that mean some services would not be financially viable under ABF.

IHPA has also determined 'low volume' thresholds that form part of the draft block funding criteria for use in 2019-20. Under these thresholds, hospitals are eligible for block funding if:

- they are in a metropolitan area (defined as 'major city' in the Australian Statistical Geography Standard (ASGS)) and they provide $\leq 1,800$ acute inpatient National Weighted Activity Units (NWAU) per annum; or
- they are in a rural area (defined as all remaining areas, including 'inner regional', 'outer regional', 'remote' and 'very remote' in the ASGS) and they provide $\leq 3,500$ total NWAU per annum.

Without pre-empting the decision of COAG, IHPA has applied these criteria in making this Determination.

States and territories have provided IHPA with a list of hospitals they consider eligible for block funding in 2019-20.

IHPA has determined their eligibility by applying the three year average annual total NWAU, calculated using the IHPA data set specifications in successive IHPA Three Year Data Plans. These hospitals are listed at **Appendix A**.

3. National Efficient Cost for small rural public hospitals

3.1 National Efficient Cost

The National Efficient Cost (NEC) in 2019-20 is \$5.319 million. This represents the average cost of a block funded small rural hospital.

The NEC was determined using the average in-scope expenditure data for 2016-17 reported in the NPHED of \$4.783 million indexed at 3.6 per cent per annum to account for price and activity growth over the three years.

3.2 Calculation of the NEC for small rural hospitals

The Pricing Authority recognises that block funded hospitals have significant fixed costs.

As detailed in **Table 1**, the Pricing Authority has determined eight different groupings for small rural block funded hospitals:

- 'Group 0' is for small rural block funded hospitals with in-scope expenditure which is below \$0.5 million. The group is determined on the basis of in-scope expenditure.
- 'Group A' to 'Group G' are determined on the basis of total reported NWAU activity.

Groups are further divided by hospital location on the basis of ASGS region:

- 'Region 1' is for inner regional, outer regional and remote areas. These hospitals are sub-divided into three types which reflect the services they provide.
 - 'Type A' is for hospitals reporting more than 30 NWAUs of either surgical or obstetric episodes.
 - 'Type B' is for hospitals that do not fall into the above category, but have more than 40 per cent of their total NWAU reported as admitted activity.
 - 'Type C' is for the remaining 'Region 1' block funded small rural hospitals that do not meet the above two criteria.
- 'Region 2' is for small rural block funded hospitals in very remote areas.

The efficient cost of a hospital is determined by multiplying the cost weight of the relevant cell in **Table 1** by the NEC.

3.3 Efficient cost for other hospitals

Other block funded hospitals, treated separately from the cost model, are defined as:

- Standalone hospitals providing specialist mental health services (e.g. Psychiatric Hospitals);
- Standalone major city hospitals providing specialist services (e.g. mothercraft, dental and dialysis); and
- Other standalone hospitals.

In 2019-20, the Pricing Authority has determined the efficient cost of these hospitals will be determined in consultation with the relevant state or territory, with reference to their total in-scope reported expenditure in the NPHEd in 2016-17. These standalone hospitals are listed at **Appendices B to D**.

4. Safety and quality

4.1 Sentinel events

In accordance with a Ministerial Direction issued to IHPA on 16 February 2017 under section 226 of the Act and consistent with the Addendum to the NHRA signed by First Ministers in June 2017, any episodes in block funded public hospitals that include a sentinel event will not be funded.

Definition

Sentinel events are a subset of adverse events that result in death or serious harm to patients.

In 2017, the Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Health Care (the Commission) undertook a review of the Australian sentinel events list on behalf of the states, territories and the Commonwealth. The updated Australian sentinel events list was endorsed by Australian Health Ministers in December 2018.

Version 2.0 of the Australian sentinel events list will be used for pricing in 2019-20. Version 2.0 of the Australian sentinel events list is available on the [Commission's website](#).

States and territories will be required to report these events to IHPA and the Administrator of the National Health Funding Pool. The deduction to block funding amounts will be calculated by multiplying the National Efficient Price 2019-20 (NEP19) by the NWAU 2019-20 for each episode.

4.2 Hospital Acquired Complications

The Addendum to the NHRA requires IHPA to develop 'a comprehensive and risk-adjusted model to integrate quality and safety into hospital pricing and funding' for a set of agreed hospital acquired conditions.

Definition

Hospital acquired complications (HACs) are complications which occur during a hospital stay and for which clinical risk mitigation strategies may reduce (but not necessarily eliminate) the risk of that complication occurring.

The list of HACs was determined by a joint working group of the Commission and IHPA.

The HACs are:

- Pressure injury;
- Falls resulting in fracture or other intracranial injury;
- Healthcare associated infection;
- Surgical complications requiring unplanned return to theatre;
- Unplanned intensive care unit admission;¹
- Respiratory complications;
- Venous thromboembolism;
- Renal failure;
- Gastrointestinal bleeding;

¹ Unplanned intensive care unit admission cannot be identified in current data sets, which means that an adjustment cannot be applied.

- Medication complications;
- Delirium;
- Persistent incontinence;
- Malnutrition;
- Cardiac complications;
- Third and fourth degree perineal laceration during delivery²; and
- Neonatal birth trauma².

Further information on the HAC list, including diagnosis codes used to identify each HAC, is available on the [Commission's website](#).

IHPA introduced a funding adjustment in the NEP18 Determination. The funding adjustment for HACs has been risk adjusted to take account of the increased predisposition of some patients to experiencing a HAC during their hospital stay and adjusts the reduction in funding accordingly.

The HAC adjustment is incorporated into the NWAU calculation used to assign volume groups for the NEC.

² In NEP18 no adjustment was applied for these HACs due to small patient cohort or other issues which have prevented development of a robust risk adjustment approach.

5. Block funded services

In 2019-20, the Pricing Authority has determined that the following services in ABF hospitals are eligible for block funding as the technical requirements for applying ABF are not able to be satisfied:

- Teaching, Training and Research;
- Non-admitted Mental Health Services (excluding child and adolescent mental health services (CAMHS))³;
- Non-admitted CAMHS⁴;
- Non-admitted Home Ventilation Services (as defined by Tier 2 V5.0 Non-Admitted Services class 10.19);
- A17 List⁵ services not otherwise priced; and
- Other public hospital programs.⁶

The efficient cost of these services has been determined for 2019-20 on the advice of states and territories, and is detailed in **Table 2**.

6. Back-casting

The following back-casting multipliers are for use by the Administrator of the National Health Funding Pool as the base for calculating the growth in Commonwealth funding under the NHRA between 2018-19 and 2019-20.

These multipliers take account of changes in the methodology used to determine the NEC between years and to account for the addition and removal of block funded services as required by the NHRA.

The Pricing Authority has determined the back-cast NEC18 is \$5.134 million for the purpose of determining Commonwealth growth funding estimated between 2018-19 and 2019-20.

6.1 Specific back-casting advice

IHPA will work with the Administrator of the National Health Funding Pool and relevant jurisdictions to determine whether a back-casting approach to any of the block funded amounts specified in **Table 3** is required. A final decision will be included in the *National Efficient Cost Supplementary Determination 2019-20*.
